Patti Fetzer and Gregg Hileman are producing wine from grapes grown in their Patianna Organic Vineyard, a 126-acre property nestled alongside the Russian River in Mendocino County. The traditions of the Fetzer family and the tenets of organic and farming form the foundation of the Patianna brand. Grape growing is rooted in the belief that exceptional quality in wine occurs when the land, the farmer and the winemaker operate in harmony. The flavor, structure and texture of Patianna's wine reflect progressive organic farming techniques, practices based on a broad knowledge of and deep respect for the cycles of nature and the expression of *terroir*.
